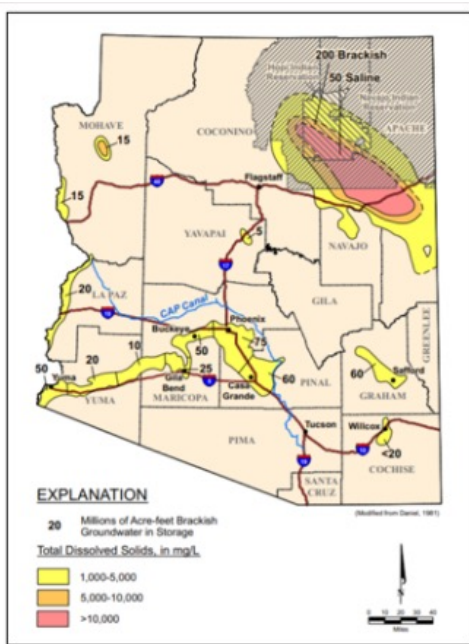


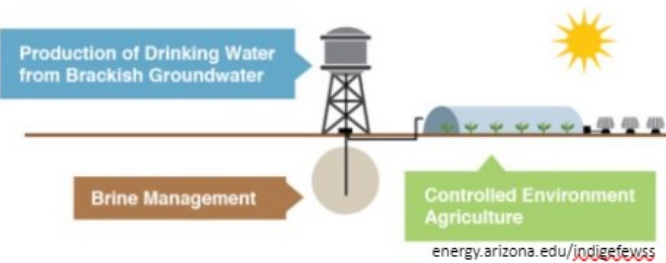

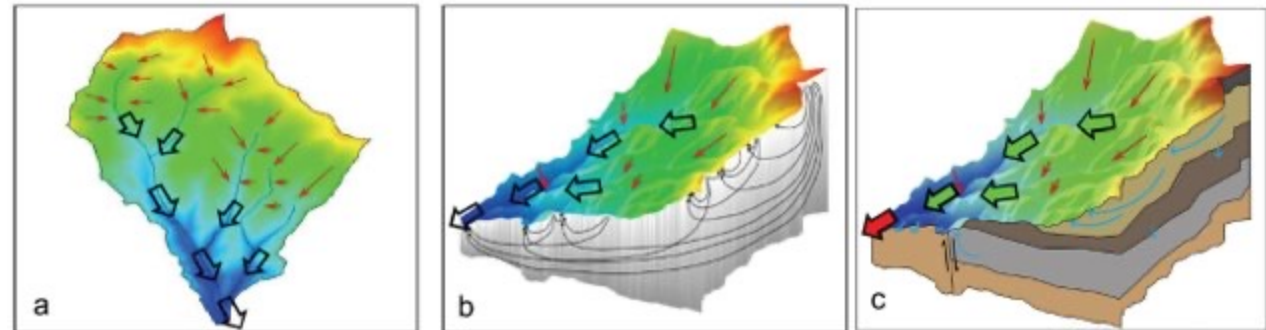
Off-grid production of safe drinking water



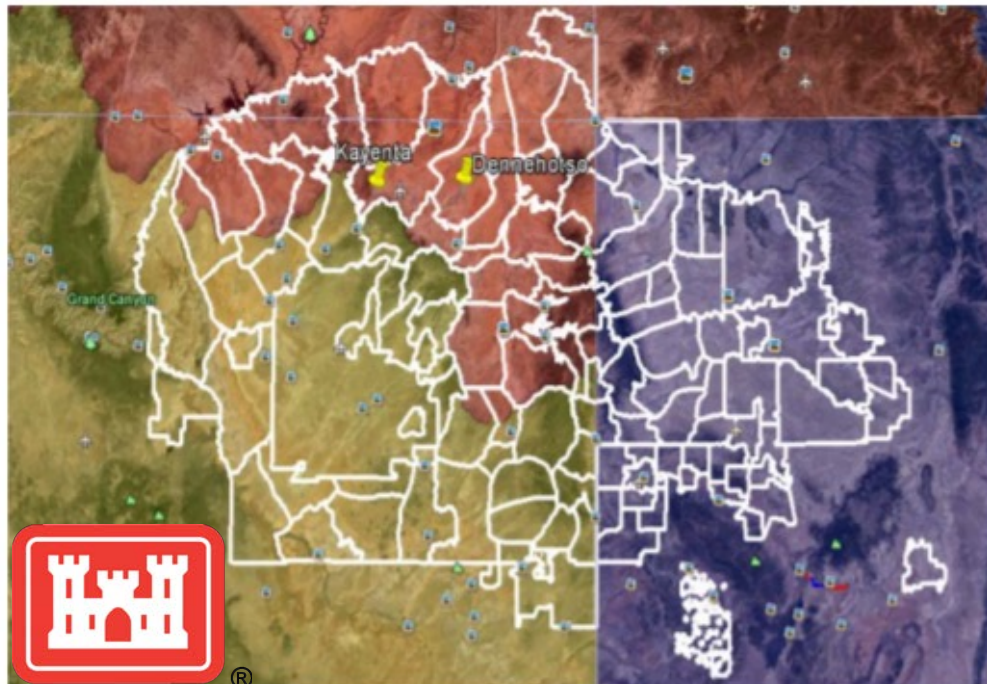
Groundwater, Surface-Water, and Water-Chemistry Data, Black Mesa Area, Northeastern Arizona
