





Scottsdale Water Supply Portfolio 1980








Annual Water Supply Portfolio

Total Assured Water Supply 140,014 acre-ft (af)








Water Supply Strategies

- Maximize renewable surface water use
- Utilize groundwater for peaking/backup
 - Safe yield (every year since 2006)
- Reclaim and reuse effluent
- Optimize groundwater recharge
 - Water Campus shallow recharge (Vadose)
 - Aquifer Storage and Recovery (ASR Wells)
 - Cooperative Recharge Agreements
- Maintain active conservation program
