


What Does "Water for Riparian Ecosystem Needs" Mean?

Water for Ecosystem Needs

The amount of water needed in a watercourse to sustain a healthy ecosystem

- Magnitude (how much)
- Frequency (how often)
- Duration (how long)
- Timing (how predictable)
- Rate of Change (how variable)
- Includes priority setting by the community as well
