BIOTECHNOLOGY

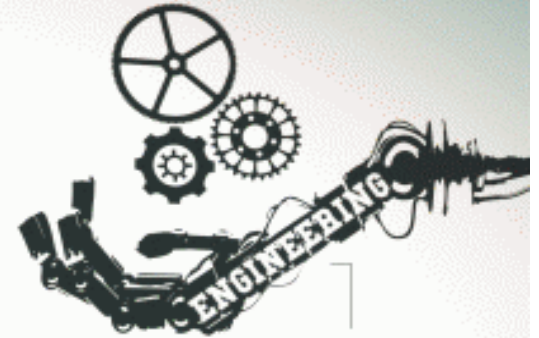

Working in a state-of-the-art laboratory, students experience skills currently performed in leading biotechnology industries including the use of microscopes, spectrophotometers, gel electrophoresis chambers, and thermal cyclers. Students investigate proteomics, plant tissue culturing, human genetic diseases, forensics, and genomics preparing them for the future.

BIOMEDICAL SCIENCE students examine the interactions of human body systems. Students design experiments, investigate the structures and functions of the human body, and use data acquisition software to monitor body functions such as muscle movement, reflex and voluntary action, and respiration.

Exploring science in action, students model organs and tissues on a skeletal manikin, solve real world cases, and play the role of biomedical professionals to solve medical mysteries.



ENGINEERING students engage in open-ended problem solving through the engineering design process. Students investigate topics including aerodynamics and astronautics, biological engineering and sustainability, and digital electronics and circuit design. Utilizing industry-leading technology and software, students develop, create, and analyze product models while learning different engineering disciplines before beginning post-secondary education or careers.

Why Advanced STEM?

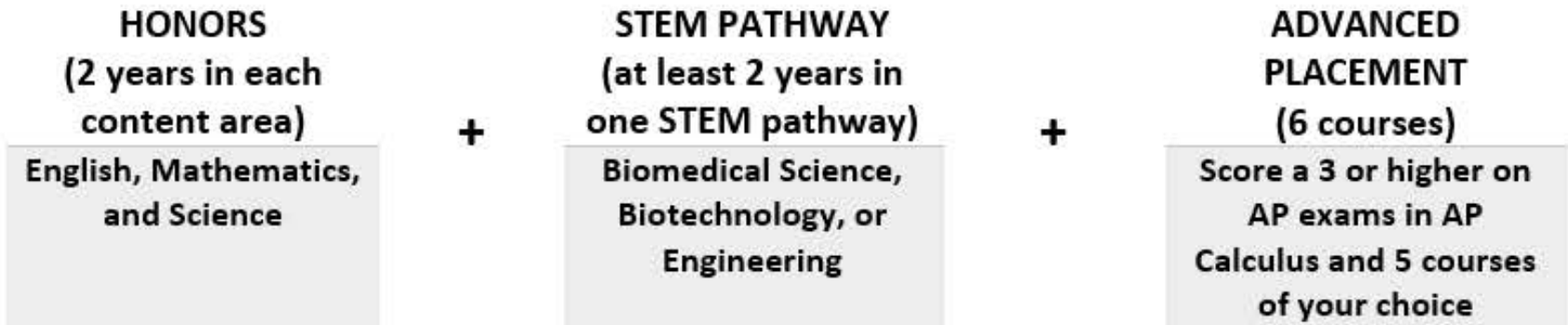
- Only **44 percent** of 12th graders are proficient in math. Of those, **61 percent** are not interested in pursuing careers in science, technology, engineering and math (STEM). That leaves a very small sliver of all 12th graders – who are both proficient and interested in STEM.
- STEM jobs are growing at a rate that is **1.7 times faster** than non-STEM jobs (CNN).
- The median STEM earnings in Arizona is \$36.63/hour, **\$18.98/hour** more than all other jobs in Arizona (Change the Equation).

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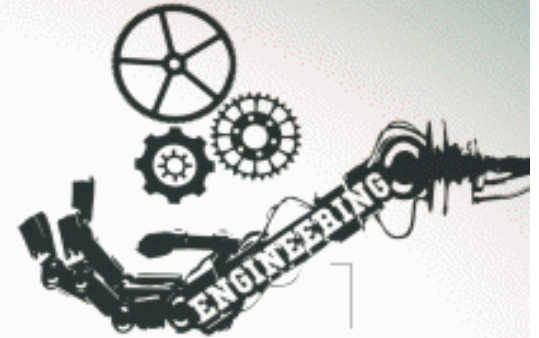
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
