The Colorado River...

- Length: nearly 1,400 miles
- Watershed: 242,000 miles²
- Sustains ≈ 40 million inhabitants in the US and Mexico
- > 80% of river flows diverted for agriculture
- River flows < Water Used
- Loss of > 90% of wetlands in some regions in the basin

- Non-for profit environmental organization, aka The Colorado River Delta Water Trust.
- Mission: to secure instream flows for the Colorado River, via permanent and temporary acquisitions and help restore critical riparian and wetland habitats in the Colorado River delta in Mexico. We deliver water on behalf of all Raise the River partners.

Water Trust Activities:

- Acquire permanent and temporary water rights on behalf of all delta ngos
- Ensure fulfillment of Minute 319 and 323 on behalf of all ngos
- Program, deliver and measure all environmental flow deliveries
- Implement wetland restoration projects in the delta Chaussé
- Develop strategies for alternative sources of water water infrastructure in the district:
- implemented largest fallowing program in the district with Conagua.

Raise the River Partners believe:

- In the resiliency of the CR Delta ecosystem
- We can restore flows in reaches of the river
- In restoring the CR delta improves the livelihoods of rural communities

- We help both countries in the understanding of ecosystem needs and potentials for restoration but also in translation and sharing messages across borders.
- We use market-based mechanisms to restore the CR delta ecosystem.



Base Flow Commitments of US-MX NGOS under Minute 323

- 9 year duration
- Total of 210,000 AF (hard target)
- Three-party contributions: US funding to conserve water, MX federal water, NGOs water rights
- NGOs will provide 1/3 of all environmental flows (70K AF)
- Minute 323 working groups
- Restoration, monitoring, water deliveries.
